

Sealing End Rails No Longer Needed

Marshfield DoorSystems no longer requires end rails to be sealed. This is due to technological improvements of the door components we use to construct our doors. The wood product materials being used today make our doors more dimensionally stable than traditional door construction practices.

Effective February 1, 1999, Marshfield DoorSystems extended the lifetime warranty to include flush doors without sealed end rails. This means you no longer need to be concerned about the job site sealing of end rails.

Marshfield DoorSystems will not seal end rails on doors in production. This includes the following: factory finished doors, plastic laminate doors, primed doors and unfinished doors.

Sealing end rails is no longer an available option on estimates and orders.

Stile and Rail doors will still require sealed end rails to comply with the Stile and Rail Warranty. Marshfield DoorSystems Contour Series™ and 9-Ply wood doors also require sealed end rails to comply with their respective warranties.
